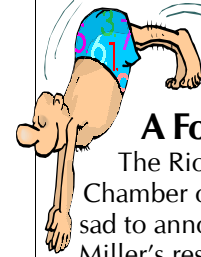

## Birth to 3 years old

- Recognizes specific books by cover.
- Pretends to read books.
- Understands that books are handled in particular ways.
- Vocalization play in crib gives way to enjoyment of rhyming language.
- Requests/commands adult to read or write.
- Produces some letter-like forms and scribbles with some features of English writing.

## 3-4 Years Old

- Knows that alphabet letters are a special category of visual graphics that can be individually named.
- Uses new vocabulary and grammatical construction.
- Is sensitive to some sequences of events in stories.
- Shows an interest in books and reading.

## Kindergarten Age

- Knows the parts of a book and their function.
- Begins to track print when listening to a familiar book being read.
- Notices when simple sentences fail to make sense.
- Retells, re-enacts or dramatizes stories or parts of stories.
